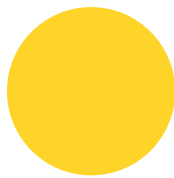

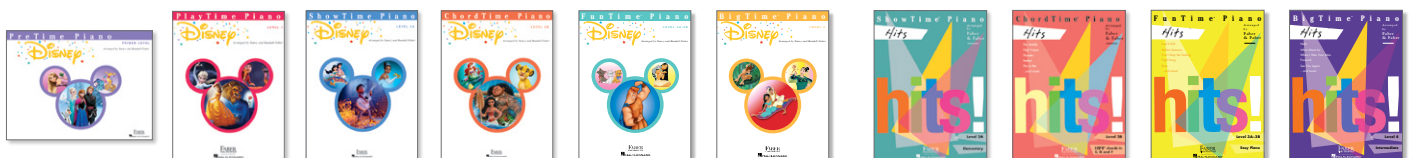

The process of guiding a person to develop the **mind** (through the *intellect*) and the **heart** (through *expression*) can awaken a desire to learn, bring forth sensitivity to artistic gesture and nuance, and foster understanding of how process relates to product.

To this end, we teach and learn with **A C E**—*analyze, create, and express*. These three action words are a statement of our philosophy for teaching and our own self-renewal.



Analyze ... Let's *Think* about It

The origin of “analyze” is Greek and means “**to break apart.**”

The way we teach a piece should “break apart” its elements to show how the music is put together.

Create ... Let's *Explore* and *Imagine*

The origin of “create” is Latin and means “**to make.**”

We can find opportunities to make choices and changes within the piece we are teaching or learning. *Choice, change, and challenge* = creativity!

Express ... Let's *Communicate*

The origin of “express” is Latin for a “**pressing out.**”

In music, expression begins with listening that primes the player to communicate an emotion or mood.

The teacher is the bridge!

A PICTURE TOUR OF CHINA

CITIES

Beijing is the capital of China. It is home to the longest wall in the world and the largest group of palaces called **The Forbidden City**.

The Forbidden City has over 8,700 rooms.

Shanghai is one of the largest cities in the world with over 24 million people. Known as the "city that never sleeps," it is home to the world's fastest train and many cultural sites, such as the **Oriental Pearl Tower** and **The Bund**, a famous city waterfront and symbol of Shanghai blending old and new.

The Great Wall is over 13,000 miles long and took over 282 years to build.

The Oriental Pearl Tower is 1,535 feet high.

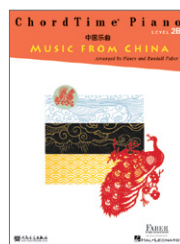

CHINESE HOLIDAYS

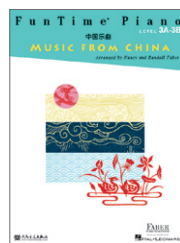
Chinese New Year
Also known as Spring Festival, this is China's most important holiday. It is a celebration to bring families together and lasts over two weeks! The main activities are decorating, a fine family dinner on New Year's Eve, enjoying the wonder of fireworks, and offering red envelopes (money) and other gifts.

Lantern Festival
The Lantern Festival is celebrated on the 15th day after the Spring Festival and marks the end of the Chinese New Year celebrations. On this day families gather together to eat sticky rice balls with a sweet filling. At night, children carry lanterns outside and try to solve riddles written on them.

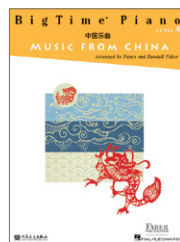
Dragon Boat Festival
This festival has existed for thousands of years and has many legends about its origins. Racing dragon boats and throwing Zongzi (sticky rice covered by bamboo wraps) into the river was a way to honor the Dragon King. People also use this day to remember the famous Chinese poet and scholar Qu Yuan (Chu Quan).

New! Piano Adventures Scale and Chord Book 3

Scales and **arpeggios** are the backbone of confident and polished playing. Practicing these two “pillars of technique” develops dexterity, control and, importantly, recognition of keyboard patterns. With this in mind, Piano Adventures **Scale and Chord Book 3** has three objectives:

- To play *two, three, and four-octave* scales and arpeggios securely and accurately.
- To understand scale geography through **transposition exercises** based on tonic, dominant, and leading tone.

Top 5 Things to See

1. Level 1 uses 3 bass clef “**Smart Notes**” as a reading tool. Have students *analyze* their locations, then play and name at lessons.
2. “**Firely**,” written in the **C-5-finger scale**, introduces *transposing* to the **G 5-finger scale**.
3. Level 1 expands artistic *expression* with legato touch, slur, staccato, and accent.

Top 5 Things to Do

- Once students have learned relative minor, ask for both the **major** and **relative minor key** as you start a piece. Coach to name the correct key by noting the harmony and final measure.

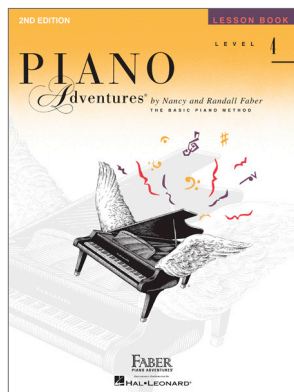

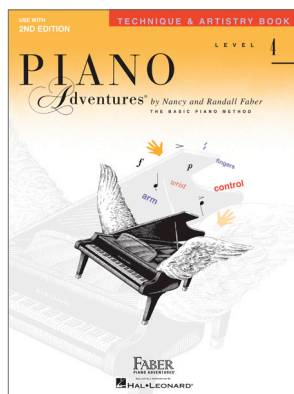

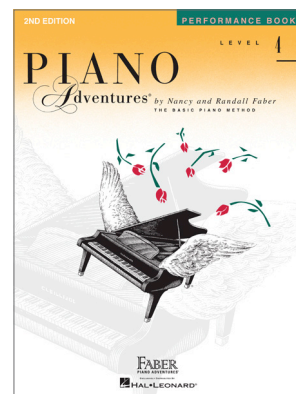

Top 5 Things to Do

1. As a regular lesson warm-up, have students play by memory the **Power Scales Routine**, with the one beat “turn-around.” (Lesson Bk. pp. 8, 20, 28, 39)
2. Build the student’s **repertoire** with 5-8 pieces “in the fingers”—ready to play for family and friends. Hear a few each lesson. Hint: Sit away from the piano to create a performance atmosphere.
3. **Memorize** a piece, a section of a piece, or an exercise in every unit.
4. Can your students write the **sharp pattern** in less than 30 seconds? Consider a manuscript book!

Top 5 Things to Do

1. Ask the students to memorize and play **Coral Reef Etude** in many keys throughout the level (Lesson Bk. p. 6).
2. Identify **cadences** marked in the pieces.

4. Throughout Level 5, have students write the **sharp/flat patterns** and key signatures *until easy*.
5. At Level 5, some students enjoy learning a *big piece* that may take several months. **Take the challenge** and continue on at a comfortable pace in Level 5 — for progress in theory, harmony, and sightreading.

The Best Advice

For busy students, the best advice is to give them music they enjoy and help them understand theory.
